CERTIFICATION

Level of Proficiency Certificate

- This certificate is awarded at the end of the course to learners who have both met the attendance requirements (i.e. 85% of classes) and obtained a positive final evaluation (i.e. 10 points or above).
- IPOR certifies communicative competence in Portuguese in accordance with CAPLE and ALTE guidelines.

Attendance Certificate

- This certificate is awarded to learners who have only attended a semester of the course for as long as they have met the attendance requirements (i.e. 80% of classes)
- It includes a reference to the number of hours attended by the learner.
- It does not certify a degree of proficiency in Portuguese.
